


What is IPT

Instrumental-Physical Theater (IPT) is a new genre of music theater, where musicians deeply master contemporary dance as a means of communication and start to speak with the audience equally both with sound and movement.



The basic idea is that as performing on stage musicians are not only heard – they are also seen. This means that besides audio channel of communication there is also a visual channel equally available. The use of visual channel brings new dimension to the stage performance and opens new horizons.



Content

Course contains three blocks:

- 1. Contemporary dance basics
- 2. Staging rehearsals
- 3. Staging performance


Contemporary dance basics include such themes as:

- presence on stage;
- physicality and musicality;
- work with professional tensions in the body and their release;
- interaction in the ensemble;
- work with action, movement and dynamic spatial composition during performance
